

NOTES:

- 1. THICKNESS OF AGGREGATE BASE WILL VARY WITH SUBGRADE CONDITIONS AND CLIMATE. COLDER CLIMATES MAY REQUIRE THICKER BASES.
- 2. PAVERS SHOULD BE PLACED ON A CEMENT-TREATED BASE IF SOIL IS EXTREMELY WEAK OR CONSTANTLY SATURATED.
- 3. CONSULT SPECIFICATIONS FOR BASE MATERIALS, SUBGRADE SOIL AND BASE COMPACTION.
- 4. PLASTIC, STEEL OR ALUMINUM EDGING MAY BE USED.
